Arizona	Prop 100	No bail for illegal immigrants charged with felonies	Prohibits bail for illegal immigrants who have committed a serious felony.	CWA Support
Arizona	Prop 102	Constitutional Amendment Relating to Standing in Civil Actions	State Constitutional Amendment will prohibit illegal immigrants from receiving punitive damages resulting from a civil lawsuit.	CWA Support
Arizona	Prop 103	English As Official Language	State Constitutional Amendment that establishes English as the official language of Arizona.	CWA Support
Arizona	Prop 107	To Protect Arizona Marriage Amendment	Amends the Arizona Constitution to preserve and protect the definition of marriage as being the union of one man and one woman.	CWA Support
Arizona	Prop 200	Arizona Voter Reward Act	Rewards one random voter with \$1 million every two years. To be eligible one may vote either in the primary or general election.	CWA Oppose

California	Prop 83	Sex Offenders, Sexually Violent Predators. Punishment, Residence Restrictions and Monitoring State of California	This referendum, if passed, will increase the penalties for violent and habitual sex offenders. Also known as "Jessica's law".	CWA Support
California	Prop 85	The Parent's Right To Know Initiative	Constitutional Amendment requiring a parent to be notified 48 hours before an abortion is performed on a minor child. There is a provision for judicial bypass and exception in case of health emergencies.	CWA Support
California	Prop 90	Protect our Homes Initiative	This initiative prevents the state and local governments from condemning or damaging private property to promote other projects or uses.	CWA Support
Colorado	Referendum	Domestic Partnerships	This will create a new legal relationship, called a domestic partnership, providing homosexual individuals the opportunity to obtain the legal protections granted only to married couples by Colorado law.	CWA Oppose
Colorado	Amendment 43	Marriage	This State Constitutional Amendment will define marriage in Colorado as only a union between one man and one woman.	CWA Support
Colorado	Amendment 44	Marijuana	This Colorado Constitutional Amendment will legalize the possession of up to one ounce of marijuana for adults 21 years of age or older.	CWA Oppose
Idaho	House Joint Resolution 2	Marriage Amendment	Idaho State Constitutional Amendment to provide that a marriage between a man and a woman is the only domestic legal union that shall be valid or recognized in this state.	CWA Support

Missouri	Amendment 2	Stem Cell Research	This would allow Somatic Cell Nuclear Transfer (SCNT) to create cloned embryos for destructive research. SCNT is cloning, the same process used to create Dolly the sheep.	CWA Oppose
Nebraska	Initiative 421	Video Gambling	Allow gambling casinos in Nebraska.	CWA Oppose
Nevada	Question 7	Regulation of Marijuana Amendment	Will allow adults over the age of 21 to smoke marijuana in private.	CWA Oppose
North Dakota	Measure 2	Taking of Private Property	Eminent Domain limits.	CWA Support
South Carolina	Amendment 1	Marriage Amendment	The Amendment defines marriage as an institution for one man and one woman.	CWA Support
South Dakota	Constitutional Amendment C	Marriage Amendment	The Amendment defines marriage as an institution for one man and one woman.	CWA Support
South Dakota	Referred Law 6	Abortion Ban repeal	This referendum was sponsored by Planned Parenthood's so-called Campaign for Healthy Families. A "yes" vote will allow the South Dakota Legislature's ban on most abortions to stand.	CWA Support
